


TIMETABLE GUIDE

A full-time load is 48 credit points. This usually equates to four units. The minimum a student may undertake is 36 credit points, as this is a requirement for an Australian student visa.

It is important to write down the unit code and location of units you are interested in, as you need this later for the timetable.

3. The labelling of the unit has the following format:

UnitCode_Location_Semester/Block_Delivery-UnitName

VU Campuses have the following codes:

- CT = City Campus
- F = Footscray Park Campus
- CQ = City Queen Campus
- S = St Albans
- G = Footscray Nicholson

VU has more campuses (e.g SY = Sydney) but they are irrelevant for exchange / study abroad students as they cannot undertake units there.

The Semester is listed as follows

- H1 = Higher Education Semester 1
- H2 = Higher Education Semester 2
- B1 = Block 1 etc

Unit Delivery

- IP = In Person (on campus)
- HY = Hybrid (part on campus, part online)
- ORT = Online Real Time (Online only) - **DO NOT SELECT ORT UNITS**

4. Using the following example

AAH2004_F_H1B1_IP – DIVIDED EUROPE

- AAH2004 = Unit Code
- F = the unit is offered at Footscray Park
- H1B1 = the unit is offered in Semester, Block 1
- IP = the unit is in person (on campus)


5. Find the units you are interested in by scrolling through the list or searching by unit code and move them to the right hand side by selecting them and clicking on >. Repeat this step until you have 4 units.


6. You should ensure that you select only one unit for each block, as shown below. If you intend to take only three units, you do not need to have three units in a row (e.g. 1B1, 1B2, 1B3), but if you don't, you will have a four-week gap during the semester (e.g. 1B1, 1B2, 1B4).



7. Now you can create your Timetable.

If undertaking units in Block (all Undergraduate/Bachelors programs), select each block individually and then click View Timetable. Repeat this process for each block.

For Postgraduate students select HE Semester 1 or 2

9. If you select Semester 1 or 2 your timetable will include all 4 blocks and you need to look at the course code or date range to find out when the course is offered. Note: the timetable is across the entire semester, not a week. In this example, Music Theory 2 is taught 22/03/2022 – 12/04/2022, and Divided Europe is 22/02/2022 – 15/03/2022, for example.
